The ASEAN Energy Storage Market is expected to reach USD 3.55 billion in 2025 and grow at a CAGR of 6.78% to reach USD 4.92 billion by 2030. GS Yuasa Corporation, Wartsila Oyj Abp, BYD Co. Ltd, SEC Battery Company and NGK Insulators Ltd are the major companies operating in this market.

Nations within ASEAN, including Thailand, Indonesia, and the Philippines, are channeling investments into energy storage solutions to achieve their renewable energy objectives and lessen their reliance on fossil fuels.

From January to May 2025, Southeast Asia has witnessed a surge in clean energy developments, with large-scale solar, wind, and battery storage projects gaining momentum across the region.

Taiwanese solar PV companies at Energy Taiwan 2025 expressed optimism about the self-generation market in ASEAN and are actively seeking opportunities for expansion and collaboration.
