# Albanian household energy storage tariffs

The Albanian government, through a proposal to the Energy Regulatory Authority, has approved a reduction in electricity prices for household consumers. Starting in February, families consuming up to 700 kWh per month will pay 8.5 ALL per kWh, down from the previous rate of 9.5 ALL. However.

Households consuming up to 700 kW/hour will pay 1 lek less until December 31, 2025. The decision, which was approved in early January by the Board of the Energy Regulatory Authority, begins its implementation today (February 1, 2025). The price reduction will only affect the category of family.

The Energy Regulatory Authority approved this Wednesday the reduce of the electricity for household consumers. The new reduced prices, will enter in force on February 1 and will be valid until December 31, 2025. For household consumers who spend up to 700 kw/h, the price will be 8.5 lek per.

The distribution network tariffs are reviewed every year but were not changed for 2023. The Connection Codes are transposed but their implementation is still to be completed. The transmission grid code was updated in 2022, but the distribution grid code from 2008 is still valid and needs to be. How much does electricity cost in Albania?

The average price of electricity in Albania, in December of 2023, has been 0.101€ per kilowatt hour. Electricity price has not changed since the last semester. Meanwhile, the average price of electricity without taxes in Albania in that period was € 0.0842 per kilowatt hour,, as in the previous period.
