Does Cyprus have 5G?

What frequency band does 4G use in Cyprus?

While the 3G mobile network in Cyprus uses the UMTS 2100 frequency band, the 4G mobile network coverage is still sparse in Cyprus, and its frequency band is not specified in the given passage.

What radio frequency is used in Cyprus?

In Cyprus, the radiowaves spectrum that has been licensed by the state (700MHz and 3.6 GHz) are very close to those frequencies that have been used for years by the existing mobile phone technologies and digital television. It is worth noting that home Wi-Fi frequencies operate at 2.4GHz and 5GHz.

Does Cyta have the fastest 5G network in Europe?

The president of Cyta Mr. Michalis Ioannidis, referring to the completion of the fastest 5G network in Europe, with 100% population coverage throughout the island, said that "this is an achievement that no other country has accomplished so far.
