Expect to spend between \$1,000 to \$2,000 depending on system size. The average cost of solar panel installation in the U.S. usually ranges from \$10,000 to \$25,000 before applying any incentives or rebates. Factors that impact this cost include panel type, roof structure, local labor rates, and permit fees.

How much does a home solar system cost?

According to studies by the U.S. Department of Energy, the all-in cost of a home solar panel system is between \$2.74 to \$3.30 per watt. ^{1,2,12} This figure includes the solar panels, the installation, and other expenses. Using these numbers, an average-sized 8-kilowatt residential solar system would cost between \$21,900 – \$26,400.

How much does solar cost per square foot?

The average system cost only drops by \$1,000 and the cost per square foot increases to \$12.83. Installing less solar will lower your cost but on a non-linear basis as there are a lot of fixed costs for installers to design, permit, and install your system.

How much does a solar energy project cost?

A large-scale solar energy project cost can run over \$100,000. These projects involve land prep, panel procurement, storage systems, and labor—but benefit from commercial tax credits and long-term ROI. Planning a proper solar panel budget is essential.

How much does a solar system cost in 2025?

Solar panels generate “free” electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

How much does a 6 kW solar system cost?

Factors that impact this cost include panel type, roof structure, local labor rates, and permit fees. On average, homeowners pay between \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt installed. For a typical 6 kW system, this comes out to approximately \$15,000 to \$21,000.
