Telecommunications in the Bahamas functions through the transmission of information by various types of technologies within The Bahamas, mainly telephones, radio, television, and the Internet. The Bahamas are connected through the ARCOS-1 fiber optic submarine communications cable, with major islands including Crooked Island (22), Cat Island (23), and Nassau (24).

When was the first telephone service in the Bahamas?

On December 16, 1933, the first telephone service to the United States from the Bahamas was introduced. After World War II, the Telecommunications Department, of The Bahamas began to make steady progress in its development. Frequency shifters, the first in the Caribbean, were installed in 1946.
