Belgian solar energy storage policy



Overview

Synergrid, the federation of Belgian electricity and gas transmission and distribution system operators, will soon allow solar panels and household battery energy storage systems with a plug and socket to be deployed on the country's electricity distribution grids. Will Belgium allow plug-in solar panels & batteries to connect to the grid?

Beginning in May 2025, Belgium will allow plug-in solar panels and batteries to connect to the grid, a move poised to transform residential energy use. This new framework will make it easier for households to integrate solar energy through mobile, plug-and-play devices.

When will solar panels & batteries be available in Belgium?

Belgium's transmission and distribution system operator says it plans to allow household solar panels and batteries with a plug and socket to connect to the grid from May 2025.

What is Belgium's energy policy?

With the publication of the Belgian Federal, Flemish, and Walloon government agreements, Belgium's energy policy has taken shape, emphasising pragmatism, energy security, industrial competitiveness, and a clear return to nuclear power.

Can you use solar energy on a balcony in Belgium?

According to the officials, Belgium is making it easier for people to use solar energy. New plug-in solar panels, also called balcony solar panels, are now available. These small panels can be easily put up on balconies, windows, or small outdoor spaces. They mentioned that people who rent or don't have a roof or garden can now use solar energy.

Should Belgium cap plug-in solar panels at 800 W per meter?

Belgian smart energy firm Innovoltus is challenging a new rule from the

Flanders energy agency in Belgium capping plug-in solar panels at 800 W per meter, arguing the region lacks authority to impose the limit. The move comes as the country begins sales of plug-in solar panels and home batteries ahead of an April 17 connection date.

Is Belgium launching plug-in solar panels for balconies?

Brussels (Brussels Morning Newspaper) – Belgium is launching plug-in solar panels for balconies, starting on April 17, 2025. Energy Minister Zuhal Demir supports this with an 800-watt limit per household to ensure safety and efficiency. According to the officials, Belgium is making it easier for people to use solar energy.
