# Brunei New Energy solar Panel Manufacturer



## Overview

---

Will Malaysia build Brunei's first solar plant?

A joint venture partly owned by a subsidiary of Malaysia's Solarvest will build Brunei's first utility-scale solar plant under a 25-year power purchase agreement (PPA) with the Brunei government. A 30 MW solar park is under development in Brunei. Seri Suria Power (B) Sdn. Bhd., a newly formed joint venture, will build and operate the project.

Is Brunei a solar country?

Tenaga Suria Brunei, launched in 2010 with a capacity of 1.2 MWp, and Brunei Shell Petroleum's 3.3 MWp plant, launched in 2021 to power its headquarters, are also part of the country's solar portfolio. 30 MW solar plant on remediated landfill in Kg Belimbing, developed by Malaysia's Solarvest, Serikandi and Brunei government's Khazanah Satu.

Who owns solarvest in Brunei?

Atlantic Blue holds a 34% stake in the joint venture. Khazanah Satu owns 30%, and Serikandi holds 36%. Solarvest confirmed in a filing to Bursa Malaysia that the government of Brunei has signed a 25-year power purchase agreement effective from the plant's commercial operation date. Construction is scheduled to finish by the end of next year.

Who owns a 30 MW solar park in Brunei?

A 30 MW solar park is under development in Brunei. Seri Suria Power (B) Sdn. Bhd., a newly formed joint venture, will build and operate the project. The company is owned by Atlantic Blue Sdn.

How much solar power does Brunei have?

According to the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Brunei's cumulative installed solar capacity stood at 5 MW at the end of 2024, unchanged since 2021. Brunei aims to reach 30% renewable energy in its

When will Brunei's largest solar power plant launch?

Deputy Minister of Finance and Economy Dato Hj Khairuddin (centre) officiated the groundbreaking at the remediated landfill site. Brunei's largest solar photovoltaic power plant (SPVPP) with a 30-megawatt (MW) capacity in Kg Belimbing is slated to launch by the end of 2026, following a groundbreaking ceremony on August 11.
