Before the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) was enacted in 2022, BESS could only access federal tax credit funding when powered by solar and required the business-owned storage to be charged with solar 75 percent of the time. The IRA expanded the investment tax credit by eliminating the requirement.

Solar tax exemptions include both property and sales tax exemptions provided by state and local governments to individuals and companies that install solar energy property. Property tax exemptions allow businesses and homeowners to exclude the added value of a solar system from the valuation of.

The One Big Beautiful Bill Act (OBBB) is set to dramatically reshape how grid scale and residential energy storage systems are treated under federal tax law.
