Beijing invested more than US\$50 billion in new solar supply capacity from 2011 to 2022, according to the International Energy Agency. BEIJING – Strong state support and huge private investment have made China's solar industry a global powerhouse, but it faces new headwinds, from punitive tariffs.

Chinese solar panel producers can't be too shocked by this situation, having faced targeted US tariffs since 2012. But they face problems of their own, with massive "overcapacity" that's draining their finances. Could that seemingly excessive factory investment yet turn out to be a boon for China —.

China's solar and windfarms would no longer be guaranteed sales at a fixed price linked to coal benchmarks, under a new policy released by the central government. The policy asks local governments to shift new wind and solar projects to a more market-based pricing system by the end of 2025. Said.

Factories left idle could provide all the additional solar panels needed for renewables tripling goal while improving energy access across the Global South. This analysis looks at the gap between the potential output of the world's existing solar panel factories and projected global solar power.
