Cook Islands Communications 5G Base Station 2025



Overview

As a small island digital state the Cook Islands faces a unique set of challenges in digital transformation, one being that it is heavily reliant on international support and cooperation to develop and fund its ICT improvement projects. Until 2019, Telecom Cook Islands was the sole provider for internet, mobile and fixed telephone communications for the country. Internet was provided via satellite which was costly to the gove.

What is the global 5G base station market size?

The market sizing and forecasts are revenue-based (USD Million/Billion), with 2024 as the base year. What telecommunications are available in the Cook Islands?

Telecommunications in the Cook Islands is limited by the country's low population and isolation, like most countries and territories in Oceania. There is only one major television broadcasting station and six radio stations. However, most residents have a main line or mobile phone.

How many connected devices are there in the Cook Islands in 2025?

Here are DataReportal 's essential headlines for the adoption and use of connected devices and services in the Cook Islands in 2025: A total of 16.1 thousand cellular mobile connections were active in the Cook Islands in early 2025, with this figure equivalent to 119 percent of the total population.

Are Cook Islands mobile networks 'broadband'?

Meanwhile, GSMA Intelligence's data suggests that 98.9% of mobile connections in the Cook Islands can now be considered "broadband", which means that they connect via 3G, 4G, or 5G mobile networks.

How many TV stations are there in Cook Islands?

There is only one major television broadcasting station and six radio stations. However, most residents have a main line or mobile phone. Its telecommunications are mainly provided by Telecom Cook Islands, who is currently working with O3b Networks, Ltd. for faster Internet connection.
