Overview

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[Paris, 20 September 2023] Q ENERGY, a major player in the renewable energies sector, Ciel & Terre the floating solar expert, Solutions30 and Perpetum Energy announce the start of construction of Europe's largest floating solar farm on the site of a former quarry in the Haute-Marne region of.

Europe's largest floating solar park, Les Ilots Blandin, has been inaugurated by Q ENERGY and Velto Renewables in the municipality of Perthes in the Haute-Marne region of France. Built on 127 hectares of former gravel pits, the park comprises over 135 000 photovoltaic (PV) modules installed on.
