Germany 5G base station electricity subsidy



Overview

Will Germany's 1.3 billion euro subsidy help offset electricity network fees?

BERLIN, Dec 3 (Reuters) - Germany's cabinet has approved a proposal for a 1.3 billion euro (\$1.37 billion) subsidy to offset electricity network fees for consumers next year, the economy ministry said on Tuesday.

How will Germany's energy subsidy work?

The subsidy will be financed through federal funds and is expected to lower the portion of network charges which currently make up about 20% of electricity bills, the ministry said. Network fees are projected to rise further to cover the substantial investments required to modernise Germany's electricity grid to support renewable energy expansion.

What is the 5G initiative for Germany?

In the autumn of 2016, the Federal Government launched its 5G Initiative for Germany, which represents a framework for action that is to support the deployment of 5G networks and the development of 5G applications at an early stage.

Does Germany have a 5G network?

The German Federal Network Agency allocated frequencies in the 3.7 to 3.8 GHz and 26 GHz bands for local 5G purposes, with more than 140 companies now able to operate their own local networks. There is no obligation for nationwide spectrum holders to enter into a national roaming agreement with local 5G network operators.
