How big is a solar roof panel



Overview

Standard residential solar panels measure 66 inches by 40 inches, or a little over 5 feet long and 3 feet wide. Each panel therefore takes up around 18 square feet. What is the standard size of a solar panel?

Individual solar cells come in a standard size of 6.14 inches square. This information is important because it means that solar panel sizes can't vary too much because of the standard size of their solar cells. While different brands and models of solar panels vary slightly in size and dimensions, their layout is the same.

How many solar panels will fit on my roof?

Sixty cell solar panels are generally six cells wide and ten high, while seventy-two cell panels are laid out six wide by twelve high. While there is some size variation in solar panels depending on the model and manufacturer, these standard panel sizes offer a good guideline when calculating how many panels you will be able to fit on your roof.

How much space does a rooftop solar system take up?

So a typical, residential rooftop solar system with 25 panels would take up about 375 square feet of roof space, but the size of your specific system will depend on your energy consumption. If you have high energy usage throughout the year, you'll likely end up with more panels, and vice versa.

Do solar panels fit on a roof?

There's no universal size for solar panels. Understanding where and how they fit on your roof is essential. It's important to know how much weight your roof can support when you buy solar panels. The idea of putting solar panels on your roof might fill your mind with dreams of low utility bills and earth-friendly power generation.

What is the average solar panel size in the UK?

For reference, as of February 2025, the average residential solar PV system in the UK is 4.6kWp, according to the Microgeneration Certificate Scheme (MCS). How have solar panel sizes changed over time?

In the case of power rating, solar panel sizes have increased significantly over the past few decades.

Are all solar panels the same size?

If solar panels contain different numbers of solar cells, then they aren't all the same size. As a general rule, the more solar cells a solar panel has, the bigger the size. Sixty-cell panels are usually smaller than seventy-two-cell solar panels. But things get a bit more complicated when we look at the efficiency of solar cells.
