How to remove and charge batteries from the battery cabinet



Overview

Slide the rechargeable battery back out of the holder, pulling up. Charge each battery pack with the included Micro USB Cables. When the charging is complete, replace the battery pack by sliding it down into the holder. Ensure the arrow is facing you and pointed down.

Zenith Drawers will have a removable rechargeable battery pack to power the lights. Depending on usage, these batteries can last for 12 months or longer. The removable battery packs are located at the back left of each drawer box. Open the drawer to access. Slide the rechargeable battery back out.

Lockout/Tagout the battery breaker in the OFF (open) position and open the two fuse holders in the battery cabinet. Lockout/Tagout the power to the SMPS AC/DC converter upstream (if applicable). Disconnect and remove all power cables from the battery cabinet. See Connect the Power Cables for.

To reduce the fire risk posed by lithium-ion batteries, the City of New York supports the installation of outdoor e-bike battery charging and swapping cabinets on public sidewalks. Through an agreement with the New York City Department of Transportation (DOT) called a revocable consent (RC).
