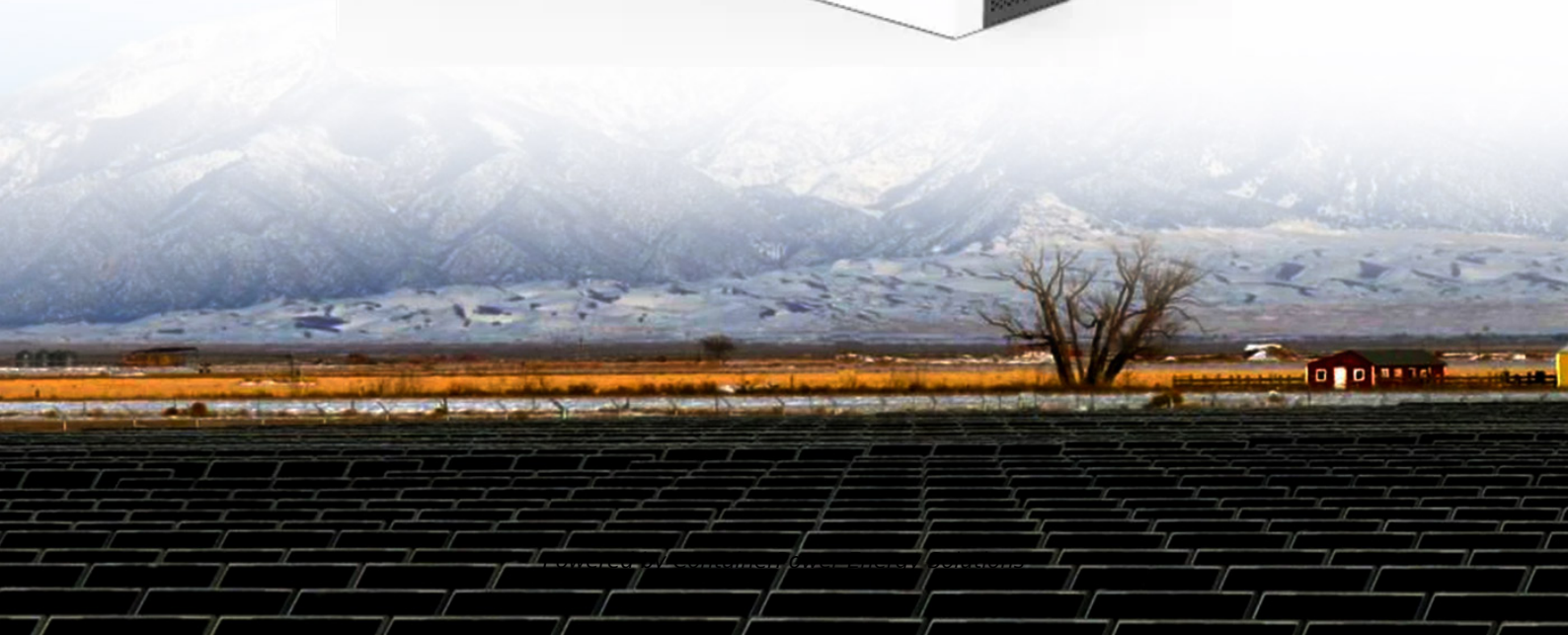

Does Cote d'Ivoire have a 5G network?

The Regulatory Authority for Telecommunications of Cote d'Ivoire (ARTCI) is considering implementing shared active telecommunications infrastructure as part of the 5G network development in the country. When will MTN Côte d'Ivoire 5G be available?

MTN Côte d'Ivoire has announced that its 5G services will be accessible by the start of the African Cup of Nations, Africa's biggest football tournament, in January 2024. Why is it important?

The implementation of shared active telecommunications infrastructure is seen as a crucial step in realizing the benefits of 5G technology.

What radio stations are in Ivory Coast?

Radio is Ivory Coast's most popular communications medium. BBC World Service broadcasts on FM in Abidjan (94.3), Yamoussoukro (97.7), Bouaké (93.9), San Pedro (103.1) and Man (89.2). Radio France International broadcasts on FM in Abidjan, Yamoussoukro, Bouaké, San Pedro and Krogho. UN peacekeepers launched ONUCI FM in 2005.

Does Ivory Coast have a good internet connection?

Approximately 1 percent of Ivory Coast residents have a fast internet connection, which is faster than the former ISDN (more than 256 kbit/s). However, around 35 percent of all residents have access to the internet in total.

Who operates the GIP in Cote d'Ivoire?

The GIP is operated by DiploFoundation. The Regulatory Authority for Telecommunications of Cote d'Ivoire (ARTCI) is considering implementing shared active telecommunications infrastructure as part of the 5G network development in the country.
