Overview

Is Kiribati launching a solar PV project?

The Oceania located nation of Kiribati has started construction on the country's largest solar PV project that's backed by the Asian Development Bank and the Government of New Zealand. It will be accompanied by a battery energy storage system (BESS). The 7.5 MW South Tarawa Renewable Energy Project (STREP) is located on the Bonriki water reserve.

Are solar panels renewable in Kiribati?

Solar is renewable and cheap to operate and maintain while genset is not renewable and depends on the supply of fuel which is not readily available in Kiribati. Are the solar panels and battery dangerous to the public?

Yes, the solar system to be installed under this project is a large-scale PV plant.
