Laying solar panels

Should you put solar panels on a flat roof?

Although it certainly is advantageous to have a roof that is inclined in the sun's direction, a flat surface will also do. With a flat roof, your solar panels will still get direct sunlight, which is the whole point of putting them on the roof.

How do you install solar panels?

The installation process involves securing the panels to the mounting structure using clamps or brackets, followed by precise alignment to ensure efficiency. Proper grounding and weatherproofing are also essential steps to protect the system from environmental factors and ensure long-term durability.

Can you install solar panels on the ground?

You can install ground-mounted solar panels, though you'll again need more

space than you would if you installed panels on a pitched roof. This is because you'll need to space out your panels so they don't cast shade on each other, just like on a flat roof.

Can you install solar panels above a roof?

If you move ahead, make sure you stay within planning permission guidelines. Your panels must not stick out more than 60cm from the roof's surface, and no part of the installation can be more than four metres above the roof. Can you install solar panels on the ground?
