# Lithuanian special energy storage battery brand



## Overview

---

Energy cells, operating under the state-owned FSOG and overseen by Lithuania's Ministry of Energy, is at the forefront of Europe's energy sector with its substantial battery energy storage system. Why are battery energy storage systems important in Lithuania?

“Power generation from renewables is growing in Lithuania, which makes battery energy storage systems an important guarantee of [grid] reliability,” said Ignitis Group CEO Darius Maikštėnas.

Will Ignitis install a battery energy storage system in Vilnius?

Vilnius-based utility Ignitis Group will install 291 MW/582 MWh of total battery energy storage system (BESS) capacity at two of its wind farms and at a hydro site, with commercial operation expected in 2027.

Who is supplying BESS power in Lithuania?

Lithuanian utility Ignitis Group has announced plans to develop 291 MW/582 MWh of BESS capacity at three of its clean energy sites and said the equipment will be supplied by Germany-based Rolls Royce Solutions GmbH.

How much electricity does Lithuania use?

“Although the average electricity consumption in Lithuania is around 1,500 megawatts, the installed capacity of both solar and wind power plants is expected to exceed 2,000 megawatts in 2025, enabling surplus electricity to be stored and supplied to consumers during peak hours”, E energija group’s CEO Gediminas Uloza noted in a social media post.

Where is Energija building a smart battery storage project?

How much balancing capacity does Lithuania need?

So the whole region would need around 1GW of balancing capacities but Lithuania alone will need around 700-800MW of capacity for FRR. We have applications to build 800-900MW of storage, and those with a letter of intent (LOI) and bank deposit total around 150MW today.
