North America Canada solar power generation for home use



Overview

With the introduction of a (FIT) in 2009, Ontario became a global leader for solar energy projects. The program was the first of its kind in North America. Thanks to the FIT program, Ontario was the home of what was temporarily the largest solar farm in the world (in October 2010) until surpassed by larger farms in China and India. Located in Sarnia, Ontario, the 97 megawatt can power more than 12,000 homes. Ontario has.

Prince Edward Island is the leader in wind and solar energy use in Canada (41%). Canadian Solar's net revenue reached \$5.2 billion in 2021, a 55% increase over 2020. On average, it costs \$3.01/watt to harness solar power in Canada. The Canadian government is investing \$964 million in renewable energy.
