Romania exports energy storage equipment



Overview

How many GW of energy storage will Romania have?

Romania is aiming to have at least 2.5 GW of energy storage installed by the end of next year and to exceed 5 GW only a year later. From ESS News According to Romanian Minister of Energy Sebastian Burduja, the country's energy storage fleet is expected to grow exponentially over the next couple of years.

Is Romania's battery storage market ready for takeoff?

Romania's battery storage market is gaining momentum, but it's not yet ready for takeoff. A recent Aurora Energy Research report reveals strong investor interest and promising early projects, but also highlights some regulatory gaps and unclear market access.

Where does Romania import electricity?

Romania exports and imports electricity to and from neighboring countries, including Hungary, Bulgaria, Serbia, Ukraine, and Moldova, and is also part of the European Union's internal energy market, which aims to create a single, competitive market for electricity and gas across EU member states.

How much money is earmarked for energy storage projects in Romania?

Romania has earmarked EUR 380 million to support energy storage projects. A further EUR 300 million has been earmarked in the Modernization Fund, EUR 150 million each for this year and next, which will mean at least 3 GW of new energy storage capacity, he said.

Should Romania Invest in energy storage?

Burduja has also called for investments in energy storage, stressing that the Ministry of Energy is making non-refundable grants available for this purpose. Romania wants mature projects that can be implemented quickly and that can help balance the system, he was quoted as saying.

How big is Romania's energy storage fleet?

From ESS News According to Romanian Minister of Energy Sebastian Burduja, the country's energy storage fleet is expected to grow exponentially over the next couple of years. "In total, at the end of next year we should have storage capacities of at least 2,500 MW, and by 2026 we should exceed 5,000 MW.
