Overview

What is a solar inverter?

A solar inverter, or solar panel inverter, is a device that converts the direct current (DC) output of solar panels into alternating current (AC). Our homes and the electrical grid use AC power, so the inverter is essential for integrating solar energy into our daily use.

Can solar panels work without an inverter?

Solar panels can work without an inverter if the devices they power use DC. However, to use solar-generated electricity for standard household appliances, which typically run on AC, an inverter is necessary to convert DC from the panels into usable AC.

How does a solar inverter work?

Also known as a central inverter. Smaller solar arrays may use a standard string inverter. When they do, a string of solar panels forms a circuit where DC energy flows from each panel into a wiring harness that connects them all to a single inverter. The inverter changes the DC energy into AC energy.
