Each year, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Solar Energy Technologies Office (SETO) and its national laboratory partners analyze cost data for U.S. solar photovoltaic (PV) systems to develop cost benchmarks. A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025.
