Tuvalu solar inverter import declaration



Overview

The Ministry of Local Government and Agriculture can issue the import permit. Declare your merchandise to customs. This must be done within 24 hours of your items arriving in Tuvalu. The declaration form is available at the customs office. Import tariffs and taxes must be paid. What is the Tuvalu national energy policy (TNEP)?

The Tuvalu National Energy Policy (TNEP) was formulated in 2009, and the Energy Strategic Action Plan defines and directs current and future energy developments so that Tuvalu can achieve the ambitious target of 100% renewable energy for power generation by 2020.

What is the Tuvalu solar power project?

The Government of Tuvalu worked with the e8 group to develop the Tuvalu Solar Power Project, which is a 40 kW grid-connected solar system that is intended to provide about 5% of Funafuti 's peak demand, and 3% of the Tuvalu Electricity Corporation's annual household consumption.

Tuvalu's power has come from electricity generation facilities that use imported diesel brought in by ships. The Tuvalu Electricity Corporation (TEC) on the main island of Funafuti operates the large power station (2000 kW).
