Ukraine accelerates the reduction of electricity costs for 5G base stations



Overview

Is Ukraine making a 'strategic shift' toward Distributed Energy Resources?

Ukraine is making a “strategic shift” toward distributed energy resources. In the two and a half years since Russia invaded Ukraine, Ukraine’s energy system has been a regular target, with attacks on thermal and hydro assets, substations, and solar units.

Should Ukraine build a decentralized and diversified energy system?

The Ukrainian government (2023) recently declared that building a decentralized and diversified energy system—one that is more resilient against military attacks or natural disasters and can enhance energy security while facilitating the transition to renewable energy sources (RES)—will be a key priority.

How has Ukraine's energy system changed since the invasion of 2022?

Ukraine's energy systems have suffered significant damage since the full-scale invasion of 2022. As of spring 2024, two thirds of the country’s dispatchable power generation capacity has fallen under occupation, been damaged or destroyed. This has been accompanied by a coordinated destruction of the grid network.

Does Ukraine need a long-term energy system?

More than ever, Ukraine needs support to transition towards a long-term energy system that is resilient, flexible and secure. The EU has the expertise, the ability and the will to help make that happen. Ukraine's energy systems have suffered significant damage since the full-scale invasion of 2022.

How can a 'energy as a service' company help Ukraine?

The most immediate step entails rapid engagement with “energy as a service” providers who can bring equipment to Ukraine, who know how to operate under adverse conditions, and who can set the stage for sequentially

indigenizing the operations.

Is Russia stalling Ukraine's 5G plans?

While many operators across Europe have focused on launching 5G networks, the same can't be said for Ukraine.
