What is the outdoor power supply in New Zealand



Overview

What type of plug does New Zealand use?

New Zealand uses power outlets and plugs of type I. Take a look at the picture below to see what this plug and power socket looks like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type I - Used in Australia, New Zealand, the South Pacific, China and Argentina.

Are there electrical outlets in New Zealand?

No, the electrical outlets in New Zealand are different from those in the United States. In New Zealand electrical outlets of type I are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for New Zealand?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in New Zealand are of type I (see images).

What do New Zealand electrical outlets look like?

When you are going on a trip to New Zealand, be sure to pack the appropriate travel plug adapter that fits the local sockets. But what do those electrical outlets look like?

In New Zealand, type I plugs and sockets are the official standard. What is the mains voltage in New Zealand?

Do universal power adapters fit New Zealand outlets?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit New Zealand outlets and many others. If your devices are not

compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

Do I need a power adapter to travel to New Zealand?

Devices with type I plugs can be used in New Zealand, but travelers from other countries will need a power adapter to plug in their devices. The voltage in New Zealand is 230 volts, and the frequency is 50 Hz. It is important for travelers to bring a power adapter that supports type I sockets when traveling to New Zealand.

Will my appliances work in New Zealand power sockets?

The answers to both of these questions generally depends on where your device comes from, though there are some exceptions to the rule. To learn more about whether your appliances will work in New Zealand power sockets, read on. New Zealand uses the Type I outlet. Some plugs will have two prongs, whilst others will have three.
