# What outdoor power supply is used in Cape Verde

On Cape Verde, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and type F are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. What type of power plugs are used in Cape Verde?

What type of power socket does Cape Verde have?

The power sockets on Cape Verde are of type C and F. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter on Cape Verde.

Do I need a power adapter in Cape Verde?

However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cape Verde, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer. The standard voltage in Cape Verde is 230 V, and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

What is the voltage in Cape Verde?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Cape Verde is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Cape Verde has standardized on type F sockets and plugs. Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets.

What type of electrical outlets are used in Cape Verde?

In Cape Verde electrical outlets and plugs of types C & F are used (see images). You can check if these are the same as in your country with the tool at the top of this page. The voltage used in Cape Verde is 220V with a

frequency of 50Hz.

Are plug sockets allowed in Cape Verde?

Typically, type C plug sockets are not allowed to be installed in Cape Verde: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type F power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer.
