Who produces electricity in Zambia?

In the generation sub-sector, independent and private power producers include Lunsemfwa, Maamba and Ndola Energy, whose entire capacity is oftaken by ZESCO, as well as those operating mini-hydro generating stations, such as Zengamina in North-Western Province, whose off-grid power systems cater to more localised needs.

How many power companies are there in Zambia?

There are three power producing and distribution companies in Zambia; (a) Zambia Electricity Supply Corporation Limited (ZESCO), a government-owned company (b) Lunsemfwa Hydro Power Limited and (c) Ndola Energy. ZESCO, the largest of the three owns and maintains 94.7 percent (2306/2434) of installed hydropower capacity, as of 2016.

What is Zambia's power generating capacity?

Zambia's power generating capacity has improved to 1,901MW at peak hour, as stated by Minister of Energy Honorable David Mabumba. Despite facing power deficits in 2015 and 2016, Zambia's power generating capacity has improved significantly.

What is the electricity access rate in Zambia?

The national electricity access rate for Zambia, as reported in the 2015 Living Conditions Monitoring Survey (LCMS) Report, is 31.4%. The access rate for urban areas is 67.3%, and for rural areas it is 4.4%.
